<b>Executive - Private Sector</b>	Our premier tier of membership. Executive Members inform and guide the direction of the organisation and receive exclusive benefits, such as invitations to events with senior decision makers. Only Executive Members can stand for our Board or attend Executive Updates.	£6,300
<b>Executive - Public Sector</b>	Our premier tier of membership. Executive Members inform and guide the direction of the organisation and receive exclusive benefits, such as invitations to events with senior decision makers. Only Executive Members can stand for our Board or attend Executive Updates.	£4,750
<b>Corporate</b>	For businesses with more than 250 employees <b>OR</b> an annual turnover more than £26 million.	£3,300
<b>Public Sector and Academia</b>	For local, regional and national transport authorities, Sub National Transport Bodies, RTOs and academia.	£2,100
<b>Medium-sized</b>	For organisation with no more than 250 employees; <b>OR</b> an annual turnover of no more that £26 million.  If your organisation has a greater turnover or employee number than the above, you will need to apply for Corporate Membership.	£2,250
<b>Small company</b>	For organisation with no more than 50 employees; <b>OR</b> an annual turnover of no more that £6.5 million.  If your organisation has a greater turnover or employee number than the above, you will need to apply for Medium Sized Business Membership.	£1,700
<b>Micro business</b>	For organisations of no more than 10 employees <b>OR</b> an annual turnover of no more than £500,000  Please note, if your organisation has a greater turnover, balance sheet or employee number than the above, <b>OR</b> is owned by a larger parent company, you will need to apply for Small Business Membership.	£350
<b>Associate</b>	Open to not-for-profit, non-Government, membership associations in the UK. Associate Members are <b>non-voting</b> members and <b>cannot</b> stand for positions within the organisation.	£600

# ITS UK Terms of Membership - 2026

## Subscriptions

1. Each member organisation pays an annual subscription in advance, running from the first of the month of payment for one year. The subscription is non-refundable.
2. Subscription arrangements and fee levels are reviewed annually by ITS UK's Board. Any adjustments to arrangements and fee levels will be applied in the following calendar year.
3. Subscriptions are invoiced to new members on commencement of membership. For members wishing to upgrade to Executive Membership, the additional amount will be charged pro rata up until your renewal date.
4. Subscriptions are subject to VAT at the prevailing rate.
5. By submitting a membership application, the applicant confirms that they are authorised to act on behalf of their company. ITS UK will treat the submission of a completed application as confirmation of authority to enter into a binding agreement.
6. **From April 2026:** Membership is continuous and will automatically renew annually unless formal written notice of resignation is provided at least 30 days in advance of your renewal date, by an authorised representative (e.g. Company Administrator) to [contact@its-uk.org](mailto:contact@its-uk.org)
1. By becoming a member, you are agreeing to abide by ITS UK's Articles of Association and by-laws.

## Access to Member Services

2. ITS UK Member services are open to all employees of the member organisation.
3. There is no limit to the number of employees who can access member services, including receiving newsletters, attending events, accessing the members area and participating in ITS UK initiatives.
4. ITS UK does not include contractors or third-party consultants to be included under a member organisation's subscription.
5. To gain access to ITS UK Member Services, employees of a given member should use their work email address linking to the member organisation. If an employee does not have the same email as their employer organisation, ITS UK reserves the right to request evidence of the individual's employment at the member organisation.
6. Membership covers one organisation only. Should a company have subsidiaries, listed as a separate trading entity on Companies House, these will be treated in general as separate organisations and will require additional memberships should they wish to join. The final decision over whether an organisation is a separate company will be taken by the ITS UK Leadership and Board.

## Invoicing

7. Terms of payment are 30 days from invoice. If a member requires a purchase order to be raised, we ask for this to be provided within 30 days from when the Member receives the renewal notice.

## Membership Benefits

8. ITS UK supports members with regular updates, mid-year check-ins, and opportunities for involvement. However, it is the responsibility of each member company to engage with activities in order to take advantage of the full value of membership.
9. Any disputes relating to membership or subscriptions will be escalated to the ITS UK Chief Executive for review, and may be referred to the Board for final decision.
